

**Amendments and additions to the GCU:
 Proposal sheet**

Art. 19.5 of the GCU

<p>1.- Present the problem (with examples and, if possible, figures giving a measure of the scope of the problem):</p> <p>Clarify the notion of approved staff and/or workshops in point 19.5.</p>	<p>2.- Show what the GCU is lacking in this respect:</p> <p>The notion of “approved” in the GCU has required clarification ever since ECMs were created.</p>

Footnote to point 19.5:

In all cases where the RU carries out - or arranges to have carried out - repair work in application of the provisions of Appendix 10 or Appendix 13, it shall do so with all due care, making use of approved workshops and/or staff and approved materials.

Approved workshops and/or staff mean that an RU has requested repair work in accordance with Appendix 10 from workshops and/or staff covered by the "safety management system" of the RU.

The RU shall provide detailed information of the work carried out to the keeper.
