This results in invoices being sent to the wrong address, and in unnecessary delays and expenditure for all parties concerned. 	<p>2.- Show why and where the GCU is deficient concerning this issue</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The GCU has taken no account of this issue to date. Addresses and contact persons for various subjects are listed, but there is no list of single central billing addresses.
<p>3.- Explain why the issue can only be resolved through the GCU contract</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Most companies nowadays have a central location for the receipt of invoices (accounts payable). This department sorts incoming bills and forwards them internally to the individual/department concerned. 	<p>4.- Explain why the issue can only be resolved through the GCU contract</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The addition of a central billing address will establish clarity for all parties to the contract.
<p>5.- Explain how the amendment / addition will contribute towards resolving the issue</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> See points 3 and 4. 	<p>6.- Assess the positive and negative effects (operations, costs, administration, interoperability, safety, competition, etc.) on a scale of 1 (very minor) to 5 (very significant)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The impacts will only be positive, since such an addition will remove uncertainty. This will reduce administration costs for all involved!
